For over 70 years Camp JCC has proudly served the young people of our community. From our home atop a sunny hill in Vestal, our goal has been to create a wholesome, safe, supervised and exciting environment from which campers learn social skills, cooperation, and teamwork.

At Camp JCC, the emphasis is on nature and outdoor fun where a camper's physical and personal growth can be both challenging and exciting. This year, everyone is invited to experience what summer camp is meant to be. Register now for Camp JCC!

## Camp JCC Counselors

Camp JCC has strict qualifications for those interested in joining our elite corp of camp counselors. Many of our counselors have attended our camp and are now seasoned staff.

Camp JCC only selects the finest counselors available for our staff. For the younger campers, Camp JCC will be staffed by experienced Early Childhood Education teachers.

To ensure program continuity and camper safety, Camp JCC has an innovative and professionally run pre-camp orientation program for all counselors. We also have an effective Unit Head Senior/Junior counselor supervisory system. In addition, Camp JCC has on-going counselor training that provides opportunities for personal growth and experience for our staff.

## Extended Day Camp

For your convenience, supervised care is available from 7:30 am - 9:00 am and 3:30 - 5:30 pm for campers attending Camp JCC at \$4.25 per hour or any portion of the hour. Prearrangements are necessary for proper staffing. If you are late for camp pick-up, your child will be placed in Extended Camp and you will be charged \$4.25 for any portion of the hour. A \$10.00 late fee will be charged for anyone picking up between 5:30-5:45 pm and a \$15 late fee for those picking up between 5:45-6:00 pm. Families who will be using the camp program as daycare may call the JCC office to get information on eligibility for adjusted fees and scholarships.

# JCC Facilities

Camp JCC is located at the beautifully renovated Jewish Community Center on Clubhouse Road in Vestal, New York. The JCC is widely recognized as a cultural, recreational and award-winning physical fitness center for residents of the Southern Tier.

Centrally located just south of the Vestal Park, the JCC provides campers with a safe, clean and varied environment from which they can enjoy all that summer has to offer.

## K'Ton-Ton

3 years old through Pre-K

9:00am-12:30pm

The K'Ton Ton campers will be under the supervision of our award winning Early Childhood Center. K'Ton Ton offers your child a half day program with a variety of camp experiences in a balanced nursery/camp type program (full day available, see Extended Camp Day). Staff are experienced Early Childhood Education teachers. The camp day includes lunch, swim, sports and games, music, arts and crafts, cooking, dance, field trips and other surprise events.

## Sabra 1&2

Children entering Kindergarten-1st Grade

9:00am-3:30pm

Sabra 1 counselors include professional Universal Pre-K staff to help transition children to the expectations of kindergarten. Campers participate in a full day program of swimming lessons (grouped by ability and age) and open swim, outdoor activities, music & dance, arts and crafts, nature and science, cooking, sports, games, field trips and other special events.

## Sabra 3 / Maccabee

Children entering Grade 2

Grade 3

9:00am-3:30pm

Older Sabras and Maccabees will enjoy trips and specialized age appropriate programs. Emphasis is on building social skills and the value of friendship. Our programs emphasize caring, sharing and respect with friends old and new. An appreciation for nature and science, music and drama, sports, cooking and art is explored through various group and selected activities in the morning. The children have a choice of different activities in the afternoon such as: arts and crafts, sports, swimming, music, drama and preparation for our all camp Talent Show.

## Osem / Eliters

Children entering Grade 4

Grade 5

9:00am-3:30pm

Emphasis is on building social skills, leadership skills and life-long friendships. Campers will gain an appreciation for nature and science, music and drama, sports, cooking and art through various group and selected activities in the morning. Campers have a choice of different activities in the afternoon such as: arts and crafts, sports, swimming, music, drama and preparation for our all camp Talent Show. The group will also participate in several exciting overnights based on their age and maturity level.

## Galgalimers

Children entering Grade 6 & 7

9:00am-3:30pm

This program has been specifically designed for the older camper. Part of the day, the group will focus on different team building activities as well as individual skills. A choice of electives and programs throughout the day will include swimming lessons, open swim, arts and crafts, nature and science, tennis, basketball, soccer and other diverse activities designed to meet camper special needs and interests.

There are weekly overnight trips exploring exciting places. The Galgalimers will also be involved in a special once a week local trip like: horseback riding, boating and camping, archery and canoeing.

This year Camp JCC offers a new and exciting program called Teen Leadership Camp (TLCs). This is a camp experience your teen is sure to never forget! The emphasis of this program is on developing relationships, social skills, communication skills, integrity, self-esteem and positive values through a diverse itinerary of day and overnight trips. Mornings at Camp JCC will be spent interacting as positive role models in the various camp groups, mentoring children ages 5-11 years old through hands-on experience. Afternoons they will be involved in a series of Leadership Development programs, Social Action projects, Event Planning, with a once a week overnight! During the 5th week of camp, the TLCs will celebrate the summer with a three day trip to St. Lawrence River and Alexandria Bay. (TLCs may sign up for individual weeks. Extra fees may apply.)

# General Information

## Camp Day

Camp JCC will begin and end each day with activities designed to encourage camp spirit and a sense of community. The camp day will begin promptly at 9:00 am.

## Camp Registration

A \$200 non-refundable deposit per camper must accompany the registration form. All registrations are accepted on a first-come, first-served basis. Full camp payment is due by Friday, May 28, 2010 or upon registration. Family discounts of 10% for your second child and 25% for your third child and 50% for fourth and subsequent children will be applied to the lower division camp fees. An early registration discount of 10% is available if you register by May 7, 2010 and pay in full by May 28, 2010. Discounts do not apply to specialty programs.

## Scholarship Assistance

As a United Way and Jewish Federation Agency, the JCC makes every effort to assure that no child is denied the opportunity to attend camp due to an inability to pay the full fee. Scholarship requests must be in writing no later than Friday, May 7, 2010. No applications will be accepted after this date.

## Extended Camp Day

Before and After Camp Care

For your convenience, supervised early morning (before camp) and late afternoon (after camp) care is offered from 7:30 - 9:00 am and 3:30 - 5:30 pm at the JCC at \$4.25 per hour for campers. Prearrangements are mandatory for proper staffing.

## Parent Orientation

In addition to preregistration community presentations and informational meetings, parents and campers have the opportunity to visit our facilities and meet the staff through personal appointments with the camp director.

## Food

Lunch is provided daily, along with a drink and snacks. The Jewish Community Center observes the kosher dietary laws. Children who medically require their own food at camp, must provide us with a doctor's note stating allergy or medical condition.

All programs and trips are subject to change due to unforeseeable circumstances.

## \* ATTENTION \*

### T-Shirt Policy

All campers receive one t-shirt on a first come first served basis. Sizes are limited. Additional t-shirts may be purchased for \$10 per shirt if available.

## Medical Requirements

A completed health examination report by your own physician is required by Friday, May 28, 2010. Health forms will be supplied by the JCC and should be picked up at the main office. No child will be allowed to attend camp or Kids Connection until completed health forms have been received at the JCC office.

## Accident Insurance

It is incumbent upon all participants to have personal insurance coverage in case of injuries which may occur on a no-fault, accidental basis. The JCC or its employees are not responsible for injuries suffered while present at or participating in JCC activities or for loss or damages of valuables or property.

## First Aid

Camp JCC employs First Aid personnel on duty at all times. Parental permission is required for treatment in case of emergency.

## Special Needs Children

To insure that your child has a positive and safe camp experience, you are required to provide an aide to accompany your child throughout the camp day if they were assigned an aide during the 09/10 school year.

## JCC Camp Agreement

All fees for Camp JCC are due by May 28, 2010 or upon registration. Parents agree that after a place in JCC Camp has been reserved for their child(ren), they will pay for the contracted period. It is understood that refunds will be made for illness over one week only, with a physician's statement. It is also understood that in case of absence, makeup days are not possible. Registration fees are NON-REFUNDABLE.
