### Dedicated Areas:


In 1968, a few contributors dedicated specific areas of the JCC to be named for a family or an individual. The gymnasium, for example, was dedicated by Rose and Jacon Olum to Kenneth Olum. Rooms and areas that are available for naming include:

### Founder's Wall:

Many great institutions bear names of their founders and committed leaders. A unique wall was erected in the main lobby of the JCC after the 1992 Capital Campaign. This wall serves as an everlasting tribute to contributors. All other contributors will be acknowledged in a permanent registry.



### Maimonides Wall

In tribute to Jewish history's most prominent physicians and scholars, a special "Maimonides Wall" was erected at the entrance of the Health and Fitness area. All health care practitioners who contribute \$5,000 or more will be appropriately recognized on this wall, as well as the Founder's Wall.
